Characteristic dimensions of metamaterials are smaller than the wavelength giving unique chances to engineer the wave propagation. At the present, the metamaterials are an active research area not only for the new physics but also as a tool for new technological advancement.

Aim and Scope of the Themed Issue

Submissions


All relevant papers will be carefully considered, vetted by a distinguished team of international experts, and published in accordance to the **Journal's standard policies**. Full research papers and comprehensive review articles can be submitted online via the journal's submission and peer review site.

Article Processing Charges

For accepted articles submitted in 2018, the journal uses the Liberty APC model, a 'Pay What You Want' model whereby authors can choose their own fair price to publish an article in Open Access. This allows authors to publish regardless of their level of funding. Authors can select the amount that they will pay on acceptance of their article beginning from '0'. The journal does not have any submission fee.
